

## **INVITATION TO ARTISTS**

## Dear Artist!

Help us make art exciting and accessible to all by participating in our **20 Artists x 20 Workshops: A Hands-on Art Extravaganza.** During this one day event, 20 artists will lead 20 hands-on art workshops on Saturday, August 12 to give the community the opportunity to explore a variety of art activities that range from metalworking/jewelry, photography, ceramics, painting and drawing, fiber and more.

We are asking each artist to lead a 45 minute to 2 hour workshop in one of our four studios or in our auditorium. The public will be encouraged to sign up for the workshops on line as spaces will be limited. We will also set up a special Kids arts & crafts area in the Garden area under the tents. This will be a free, family oriented event.

The 20 Artists X 20 Workshops will kick off with a TASTE OF THE ARTS GALA Friday night, August 11<sup>th</sup>. Ticket sales will help fund the event, and a portion of each ticket sale will go to support adult class and children's summer camp scholarships.

As a 20x20 Workshop artist, you will have the opportunity to promote your classes during your workshops. You will be invited to participate in our 20x20 exhibit. Additionally, you will be invited to show and sell your work during the Gala and Saturday workshop events.

- You will be promoted in all of our event marketing materials.
- There is no fee to the artist to participate in the sales event. However, all works must be for sale, and remain
  on display for the duration of the Saturday event. Display spaces will be provided on draped tables and spaces
  are assigned by The Arts Center staff. The ARTS Center will handle all sales transactions (Artists 60% / Center
  40%).
- Each 20x20 workshop artist will receive two complementary tickets to the TASTE OF THE ARTS GALA, Friday, 8/11 from 6pm-10pm.

**Artists of all mediums are invited to apply.** Categories include: ceramics, painting, drawing, leather, metalwork, sculpture, photography, glass, fiber, jewelry, woodwork as well as mixed and new media.

**PROPOSAL DEADLINE:** Proposals must be submitted by Friday, April 28 to be considered. Workshop space is limited and it is recommended that you return your application as soon as possible.
